



- Create Pinterest account
- Switch to business account
- Choose niche
- Design Logo & Select Company Name
- Put username in www.pinterest.com/\_\_\_\_ which can be find in the edit profile in the setting section
- Decide on board you want to create by searching for the top sub-niche from your broad Niche
- Create at least 5 Boards
- Edit your boards

Go to Affiliate Program (Shareasale)

- Sign up to shareasale affiliate website
- Wait for approval







Return to pinterest

Put 15 pins into the board you created

Are the pins relevant to the board image you want to project to your audience?

Did you make sure you didn't pin images from direct merchant or company?

Are the Pin in the Pinterest image format?

Increase Your followers

Search board for your niche & select the board

Add the followers of the person whose the board belongs to

Distribute the number of followers for the remaining boards

Repeat this process after 2 hours





Join Group board relevant to your niche by either sending email or clicking on invite button

After getting approved by affiliate program

- Start creating affiliate link
- Create product showcase in canvas in Pinterest format
- Edit the title and description
- Add keyword obtained from either Pinterms or in Ads or in the Pinterest search bar
  - Add Hashtags to the description
  - Put the Affiliate Links in the destination link tab without using url shortener

Add some of the affiliate products in the group board you have been approved to
